

**Introduction:** The Kent Junior Chess Coaching Programme will provide tuition under the Institute of Chess Scheme, the UK national chess coaching programme. The courses are broad-based, structured and highly recommended for all novices and all those teaching juniors in school or out-of-school chess clubs and a necessity for all those aspiring to the primary age County teams before they seek more specialised coaching.

**Dates and Venues:**

1. Saturday 9 January 2010: Eltham College Junior School, The Grange, Mottingham Lane, Mottingham SE9 4RW.
2. Sunday 31 January 2010: Barming Primary School, Belmont Close, Barming ME16 9DY.

**Timetable (approximate) for each day:**

- Introduction: 9.45.
- 1<sup>st</sup> coaching session: 10.00~11.00.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> coaching session: 11.30~12.30.
- Lunch Break: 12.30~1.30.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> coaching session: 1.30~2.30.
- 4<sup>th</sup> coaching session: 3.00~4.00.
- Departure: 4.15.

**Food/Drinks:** The KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering will be at this event. In addition to hot snacks, there will be crisps, confectionery and fizzy/hot drinks, all at reasonable prices.

**Eligibility:** The coaching is for both primary and secondary school children and those coaching them and is designed for novices through to junior County players and trainers. Your details will be held on the KJCA database solely to inform you about junior chess events. You will be split into 5 groups reflecting your existing standard of play, as follows:

- Level 1 Coaching Group (CG): for those graded up to 30. 2-day course: exam on 31/01/10.
- Level 2 CG: for those graded 31~65 or who have passed Bronze. 2-day course: exam on 31/01/10.
- Level 3 CG: for those graded 66~100 or who have passed Silver. 4-day course: exam at end of next season (probably in February 2011).
- Level 4 CG: for those graded 101~135 or who have passed Gold. 4-day course: exam at end of next season (probably in February 2011).
- Level 5 CG: for those graded 136+ or who have passed Platinum. 4-day course: exam at end of next season (probably in February 2011).

**Behaviour/Supervision:** The KJCA is most grateful to both the schools concerned for the use of their facilities. Please treat the school premises with the utmost respect. A high standard

of behaviour is expected at all times. The KJCA and its officials accept no responsibility for any damage, theft or accident to the person or property of anyone attending any of these events. They are unable to act in loco parentis for children. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children throughout the entire duration of each of these events at all times when they are not actually in a coaching session. Children under the age of 8 must remain under sole parental supervision throughout but this supervision may be shared between adults in the case of children of 8 years old and over. **Content: Level 1 CG:** movement/value of pieces; recording moves; castling; checking; checkmating. **Level 2 CG:** basic openings; basic tactics. **Level 3 CG:** opening theory; basic end games; more complex tactics. **Level 4 CG:** advanced opening theory; complex end games; reference materials/comprehension. **Level 5 CG:** complex/unusual openings; middle game tactics; planning. Revision guides available at [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org). Practice at home is essential.

**Directions/Parking:**

1. Eltham College Junior School: Just off south side of A20 just west of Mottingham. From roundabout junction of A20 and A205 (South Circular), take A20 eastbound exit. After just over ¼ mile, turn right across carriageway into Mottingham Lane. School entrance is just over ½ mile on right. Plenty of parking on site.
2. Barming Primary: Is just off the north side of the A26 about 2 miles west of Maidstone. From the Bull Inn. Take third turning on right – Heath Road. Then take first turning on right – Beverley Road and again take first turning on right – Belmont Close. School is at far end of close. There is parking on site. If it becomes full, please park free along the Close with consideration.

**Entry Fees:** £12.50/entrant per day OR Level 1 and 2 CGs: 2-days: £22.50/entrant OR Level 3, 4 and 5 CG: 4-days: £45/entrant. Fees carried forward only if entrant playing in representative match or NCJS qualifying event. Late entry fee: £4/entrant payable for entries posted later than 5 days before any coaching day. Donations, including unclaimed refunds, most welcome and will be used to invest in local junior chess. Cheques payable to KJCA. Post entries to Entries Manager, contact details overleaf. Only entries where we have your email will be acknowledged. Direct enquiries to Entries Manager.
