

**Conditions of Entry:** By entering this event, you agree to be bound by all terms and conditions in this form. Your details will be held on the KJCA database solely for the purpose of our informing you about junior chess events. Grades may be published on ECF website. Results and photos may appear on the KJCA website, [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org), and in the Press.

**Sections:** U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 & U18: ages as on 31 August 2009. No grading limit except parents (U18 section) who must be U181. All sections part of 2009~10 Kent Junior Grand Prix & 2009~10 ECF Grand Prix: rules at venue & on ECF website, [www.englishchess.org.uk](http://www.englishchess.org.uk). U12, U14, U16 & U18 sections are 2009~10 Kent Championships. If any section has too few entries, Organiser has right to combine sections.

**Rates of Play:** All sections are Swiss events: all entrants play in every round. **U8, U10, U12:** 6 rounds at 30 minutes per player. **U14, U16, U18:** 5 rounds at 40 minutes per player. Clocks are used in all sections. Help will be given to anyone unfamiliar with them. FIDE Rapidplay Rules apply. Default time: 20 minutes. Decisions of Chief Arbiter will be final.

**Timetable:**

- U8~U12 Rounds: 1: 9.30~10.30; 2: 10.50~11.50; 3: 12.10~1.10; 4: 1.30~2.30; 5: 2.50~3.50; 6: 4.10~5.10.
- U14~U18 Rounds: 1: 9.30~10.50; 2: 11.05~12.25; 3: 12.40~2.00; 4: 2.15~3.35; 5: 3.50~5.10.
- Prize-giving: By 5.45.

**Individual Prizes:** In U8 section, top 3 players and top girl win mini-trophies. In other sections, cash prizes for top 3 players and top girl and mini-trophy for winner. In a tie, cash prizes will be split. Total cash prizes in each section: U10 £35; U12 £70; U14 £85; U16 £105; U18 £120. Cups for U12, U14, U16 and U18 Championships will be held for 1 year. In a tie, the winner will be calculated from respective sums of opponents' scores. Prizes will not be awarded before the prize-giving. Kent-based players not collecting their prizes will forfeit them.

**Team Prize:** Scores of top 3 juniors from a school will count towards a team trophy. In a tie, winner will be calculated from respective sums of opponents' scores.

**Food/Drinks:** KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering will be at this event. In addition to hot snacks, there are cakes, crisps, confectionery & fizzy/hot drinks, all at reasonable prices.

**Behaviour/Supervision:** The KJCA is most grateful to The Schools at Somerhill for the use of their facilities. Please treat the school premises with respect. A high standard of behaviour is expected at all times. Players entering or leaving the playing area while games are in

progress should do so quietly. KJCA and its officials accept no responsibility for any damage, theft or accident to the person or property of anyone attending this event. They cannot act in loco parentis for children. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children throughout entire duration of this event. Children under age of 8 must remain under sole parental supervision throughout but this supervision may be shared between adults in case of children of 8 years old and over. The full KJCA Protection Policy applies, as on [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org) and on display at the venue.

**Kent Junior Grand Prix:** All juniors can earn Grand Prix (GP) points from any section. The GP prize fund totals up to £1,700. Full GP rules can be found on KJCA website. GP has 4 sections (1<sup>st</sup> prize in brackets): U9 (£100), U11 (£125), U14 (£150) and U18 (£200). To be eligible for a prize at the 2010 GP Final, you must be eligible to play for Kent. Appearance for another team in an inter-County event will result in automatic disqualification. Multipliers for today's event are as follows: U9GP: U8 section x2; U10 x4; U11GP: U10 x2; U12 x5; U14GP: U12 x3; U14 x6; U16 x7.2; U18GP: U16 x6; U18 x8.4. If sections are combined, the higher multiplier will apply.

**Kent Schools Grand Prix:** Eligibility criteria are same as in the Kent Junior GP. Prize-winners at the 2010 GP Final will be the primary and secondary school with the highest total scores from its best 3 eligible players at each GP event.

**Directions/Parking:** The school is on the B2017 just off the A21 and A26 south east of Tonbridge. From the M25 Junction 5, take the A21 southbound. After about 10 miles, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> A26 slip road (to Tonbridge). At the roundabout, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (A26 to Maidstone – Woodgate Way). Continue for over ½ mile to the next roundabout and take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (B2017 – Tudeley Road). After about ¼ mile, school entrance is on the right. There is ample parking on site.

**Entry Fees:** £9 per player. Late entry fee: £1/player payable for entries posted after 5/4/10. Last minute fee: £4/player payable in lieu for entries notified after 7/4/10. Email/phone/web-based entries permitted exceptionally with full details from 8/4/10. Fees remain due. No refunds after 7/4/10. KJCA members may deduct £1. ECF members may claim Game Fee refund at end. £10 fee for changing section from 9/4/10. Players arriving without prior notification after 08:50 may be excluded from Round 1. Donations, including unclaimed refunds, most welcome and will be used to invest in local junior chess. Please make cheques payable to KJCA and post entries to Entries Manager – contact details overleaf. Only entries where we have your email will be acknowledged.
