

**Entry to this Event:** All juniors (Under 18) are most welcome. There is no grading limit. Results will be sent for Rapidplay grading and results, grades and photos may be used on the Kent Junior Chess Association website, [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org), and in the Press. Your details will be held on the KJCA database solely to inform you about junior chess events.

**Sections:** Under 9, U11, U14 and U18: ages as on 31 August 2009. All sections are part of the 2009~10 Kent Junior Grand Prix (see later). If there are insufficient entries in any section, the Organiser reserves the right to combine sections.

**Rates of Play:** All sections are Swiss events: all competitors play in every round. **U9 and U11:** 6 rounds of 30 minutes each. **U14 and U18:** 5 rounds of 40 minutes each. Clocks will be used in all sections. Help will be given to anyone unfamiliar with them. FIDE Rapidplay Rules apply. Default time: 20 minutes. Decisions of the Chief Arbiter will be final.

**Timetable:**

- U9, U11 Round Times: 1: 9.30~10.30; 2: 10.50~11.50; 3: 12.10~1.10; 4: 1.30~2.30; 5: 2.50~3.50; 6: 4.10~5.10.
- U14, U18 Round Times: 1: 9.30~10.50; 2: 11.05~12.25; 3: 12.40~2.00; 4: 2.15~3.35; 5: 3.50~5.10.
- Prize-giving: Probably by 5.45.

**Individual Prizes:** In the U9 section, the top 3 players and the top girl will win mini-trophies. In the other sections, there will be cash prizes for the top 3 players and the top girl and a mini-trophy for the winner. In the event of a tie, cash prizes will be split. Total cash prizes in each section will be as follows: U11 £50; U14 £85; U18 £120. Prizes will not be awarded before the prize-giving. Kent-based players not collecting their prizes will forfeit them.

**Team Prize:** Scores from the top 3 juniors from any school will count towards a team trophy. In a tie, the winner will be calculated from the respective sums of opponents' scores.

**Food/Drinks:** The KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering will be at this event. In addition to hot snacks, there will be cakes, crisps, confectionery and fizzy and hot drinks, all at reasonable prices.

**Behaviour/Supervision:** The KJCA is most grateful to Sutton Valence School for the use of its facilities. Please treat the school premises with respect. A high standard of behaviour is expected at all times. Players entering or leaving

the playing area while other games are in progress should do so quietly. The KJCA and its officials accept no responsibility for any damage, theft or accident to the person or property of anyone attending this event. They are unable to act in loco parentis for children. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children throughout the entire duration of this event. Children under the age of 8 must remain under sole parental supervision throughout but this supervision may be shared between adults in the case of children of 8 years old and over. The full KJCA Protection Policy applies as at [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org) and on display at the venue.

**Kent Junior Grand Prix:** All juniors can earn Grand Prix (GP) points from any section. The GP prize fund totals up to £1,700. The full GP rules can be found on the KJCA website. The GP has 4 sections (1<sup>st</sup> prize in brackets): U9 (£100), U11 (£125), U14 (£150) and U18 (£200). To be eligible for a prize at the 2010 GP Final, you must be eligible to play for Kent. Appearance for another team in an inter-County event will result in automatic disqualification. Multipliers for today's event are as follows: U9 GP: U9 section x3; U11 x4.5; U11 GP: U11 x3; U14 x6; U14 GP: U14 x4.8; U18 x7.2; U18 GP: U18 x7.2. If sections are combined, the higher multiplier will apply.

**Kent Schools Grand Prix:** Eligibility criteria are same as in Kent Junior GP. Prize-winners at 2010 GP Final will, therefore, be the primary & secondary school with highest total scores from its best 3 eligible players at each GP event.

**Directions/Parking:** The school is on the A274 south-east of Maidstone. From the M20 Junction 8, take the A20 eastbound to Harrietsham for over ¼ mile. Then turn right at the roundabout on to the B2163 to Leeds. After 1¾ miles, turn left on to the A274 to Sutton Valence and Headcorn. After ¾ mile, the school entrance is on the left. There is plenty of parking on site.

**Entry Fees:** £9 per player. Late entry fee: £1/player payable for entries posted after 24/5/10. Last minute fee: £4/player payable in lieu for entries notified after 26/5/10. Email/phone/web-based entries permitted exceptionally with full details from 27/5/10. Fees remain due. No refunds after 26/5/10. KJCA members may deduct £1. ECF members may claim Game Fee refund at end. £10 fee for changing section from 29/5/10. Players arriving without prior notification after 08:50 may be excluded from Round 1. Donations, including unclaimed refunds, most welcome and will be used to invest in local junior chess. Please make cheques payable to KJCA and post entries to Entries Manager- contact details overleaf. Only entries where we have your email will be acknowledged.
