

**Introduction:** The Kent Junior Chess Coaching Programme will provide tuition under the Institute of Chess Scheme, the UK national chess coaching programme. The courses are broad-based, structured and highly recommended for all novices and all those teaching juniors in school or out-of school chess clubs and a necessity for all those aspiring to the primary age County teams before they seek more specialised coaching.

**Dates and venues:**

- Sun 9 Oct 2011: Amherst School
- Sat 5 Nov 2011: Eltham College Junior School
- Sat 7 Jan 2012: Sandhurst
- Sun 26 Feb 2012: Barming

**Food/Drinks:** The KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering will be at these events. In addition to hot snacks, there will be cakes, crisps, confectionery and fizzy/hot drinks, all at reasonable prices.

**Eligibility:** The coaching is for both primary and secondary school children and those coaching them and is designed for novices through to junior County players and trainers. Your details will be held on the KJCA database solely to inform you about junior chess events. You will be split into 5 coaching groups reflecting your existing standard of play, as follows:

- Level 1:** 2-day course with exams 5 Nov 2011 & 26 Feb 2012; for those with grades up to 30.
- Level 2:** 2-day course with exams 5 Nov 2011 & 26 Feb 2012; for those graded 31 to 65 or who have passed Level 1.
- Level 3:** 4-day course with an exam on 26 Feb 2012; for those graded 66 to 100 or who have passed Level 2.
- Level 4:** 4-day course with an exam on 26 Feb 2012; for those graded 101 to 135 or who have passed Level 3.
- Level 5:** 4-day course with an exam on 26 Feb 2012; for those graded over 135 or who have passed Level 4.

**Behaviour/Supervision:** The KJCA is most grateful to the schools that have provided use of their facilities. Please treat the school premises with respect. A high standard of behaviour is expected at all times. The KJCA and its officials accept no responsibility for any damage, theft or accident to the person or property of anyone attending these events. They are unable to act in loco parentis for children. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children

throughout the entire duration of these events. Children under the age of 8 must remain under sole parental supervision throughout but this supervision may be shared between adults in the case of children of 8 years old and over. **Content:**

- Level 1:** movement and value of pieces; recording moves; castling; checking; checkmating
- Level 2:** basic openings; basic tactics.
- Level 3:** opening theory; basic end games; complex tactics.
- Level 4:** advanced opening theory; complex end games; reference materials/comprehension
- Level 5:** complex/unusual openings; middle game tactics; planning.

**Directions/Parking:**

- Amherst School:** TN13 2AX; From the M25 at exit 5 follow signs to A21 Sevenoaks/Hastings. Exit the A21 onto the A25 towards Westerham. Turn left into Witches Lane, entrance is on the right. There is limited parking on site, please park free along Witches Lane with consideration.
- Sandhurst Primary:** TN18 5JE; From the M25 at exit 5 follow signs to A21 Hastings. After about 20 miles stay on A21 heading to Hastings/Flimwell then follow signs to Hawkhurst/A268. Follow Hawkhurst Rd/A268 for about 6 miles through Sandhurst to where Rye Road meets Back Road and Oaks Forstal. Please park with consideration.
- Barming Primary:** ME16 9DY; From the A26, turn north into North Street almost opposite the Bull Inn. Take third turning on right – Heath Road. Then take first turning on right – Beverley Road and again take first turning on right – Belmont Close. School is at far end of Belmont Close. There is parking on site. If it becomes full, please park free along Belmont Close with consideration.
- Eltham College Junior School:** SE9 4RW; From roundabout junction of A20 and A205 (South Circular), take A20 eastbound exit. After just over ¼ mile, turn right across carriageway into Mottingham Lane. School entrance is just over ½ mile on right. Plenty of parking on site.

**Entry Fees:** £12.50 per entrant per day OR Level 1 and 2: 2-days: £22.50 per entrant OR Level 3, 4 and 5: 4-days: £45 per entrant. Fees carried forward only if entrant playing in representative match or NCJS qualifying event. Late entry fee: £4 per entrant payable for entries posted later than 5 days before any coaching day. Donations most welcome. Please make cheques payable to KJCA. Post entries to Entries Manager, contact details overleaf. Only entries with an e-mail address will be acknowledged. Please direct any enquiries to Entries Manager. Full Event Entry Regulations apply as on KJCA website and on display at venue.

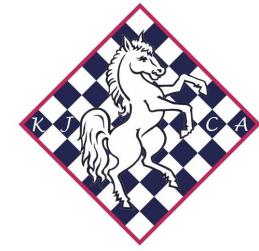
