**Entry to this Event:** Juniors may enter as individuals or with adult(s) as a team of family or friends or with other juniors. Apart from parents, juniors may be partnered by other relatives, friends of the family, teachers at their school, members of their chess club or by other juniors, with a limit of 5 on the number of players in a team. In all-junior teams, the oldest junior will count as an adult. The entry to this tournament is restricted to an individual grading limit of U181 and an average team grading limit of U151. Some exceptions may be granted subject to the Chief Controller's discretion, suitable inducement and the right to impose arduous conditions on high-graded players or teams! Results will not go for grading.

**Sections:** All players compete in the same section.

**Rates of Play:** The tournament is a Swiss event so that all competitors play in every round. There are 5 rounds of 30 minutes per player each. Clocks will be used on all boards. There will be help for anyone unfamiliar with them. FIDE Rapidplay Rules apply. Default time: 20 minutes. The Chief Controller's decisions will be final.

### Timetable:

- Introduction: 10.00.
- Rounds: 1: 10.10~11.10; 2: 11.30~12.30; 3: 1.30~2.30; 4: 2.50~3.50; 5: 4.10~5.10.
- Prize-giving: As soon as possible after the final round, probably by 5.45.

**Team Prize:** The best combined score from one adult and one junior in each team count in each round. The winning team is the one with the highest total accumulated from their score in each round. There is a perpetual trophy for the winning team, which may be retained for one year. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by calculating the respective sums of opponents' scores. There will be a prize for the most inventive family team name (see entry form).

**Individual Prizes:** There are mini-trophies for the best adult and the best junior. In the event of a tie, the winners will be decided by calculating the respective sums of opponents' scores. There are also a host of other fun prizes for memorable performances (good and bad!) during the day. All players should, therefore, stay for the prize-giving.

**Food/Drinks:** The KJCA Volunteer Mobile Catering will be at this event and food and drinks will be as listed under the separate heading of Christmas Party.

**Behaviour/Supervision:** The KJCA is most grateful to Rosemead Prep for the use of its facilities. Please treat the school premises with respect. A high standard of behaviour is expected at all times. Players entering or leaving the playing area while other games are in progress should do so quietly. The KJCA and its officials accept no responsibility for any damage, theft or accident to the person or property of anyone attending this event. They are unable to act in loco parentis for children. Parents/guardians are responsible for their children throughout the entire duration of this event. Children under the age of 8 must remain under sole parental supervision throughout but this supervision may be shared between adults in the case of children of 8 years old and over. The full KJCA Protection policy applies as at [www.kjca.org](http://www.kjca.org) and on display at the venue.

**Party:** The entry fees include entry to the KJCA Party. Hot and soft drinks will be available all day, free of charge. After Round 2, there will be Party food.

**Directions/Parking:** Rosemead Prep School is just off the A205, Thurlow Park Road.

**Entry Fees:** Individual entries, including the Party, are £17 each for KJCA members and £20 for non-members. Additional Team members, including the Party, are £13 each for members and £15 for non-members. A last minute entry fee of £5 per individual entrant or team member is payable in lieu for entries notified after 25<sup>th</sup> January 2014. Email/phone entries are permitted exceptionally with full details. Fees remain due. No refunds after 21<sup>st</sup> January. Players arriving without prior notification after 9.30 may be excluded from Round 1. The Party for non-players is £6 each. Any donations, including unclaimed refunds, will be most welcome and will be used to invest in junior chess in Kent and SE London. Please make cheques payable to the KJCA. Please post entries to the Entries Manager, contact details overleaf. Only entries where we have your email address will be acknowledged. Please direct any enquiries to the Entries Manager. The Kent Junior Chess Association ("KJCA") is responsible for the development of junior chess throughout Kent and South-East London, having been established even before the Second World War. KJCA is staffed entirely by volunteers, all of whom provide a valuable service in contributing to the organisation, with all surplus earnings being re-invested to provide playing opportunities for the benefit of its juniors.

Throughout most of the year, KJCA runs tournaments and coaching days across Kent and South East London. We also select our junior county teams from Under 9 up to Under 18 age groups to compete in inter-County Championships. The strongest players are encouraged to compete for national and even international representation.

KJCA also liaises closely with local schools and chess clubs to promote the development of school chess teams, so that juniors can maximise their playing potential and contribute towards playing for their county.

An important part of our vision is that families attending our events experience an enjoyable day in pleasant surroundings and a friendly atmosphere, as well as a high quality standard of competitive chess. Win, lose or draw, we hope that you will make friends and come back again. What is more, our catering offers excellent value for money and only adds to the day's enjoyment!

The strong team spirit engendered among Kent Juniors has resulted in our winning many inter-county titles over the years. Some of our players have gone on to gain international recognition, as well as becoming FIDE, International and Grand Masters.

All of these skills, we hope, will also complement both the academic and social development of our juniors.
